A) PURSUE YOUR FREEDOM

Be Determined

Push Through to Touch the Hem of His Garment: Matt 9:20-21 *Just then a woman who had been subject to bleeding for twelve years came up behind him and touched the edge of his cloak. 21 She said to herself, "If I only touch his cloak, I will be healed." NIV*

Be Like the Man Let Through the Roof: Mark 2:2-5 So many gathered that there was no room left, not even outside the door, and he preached the word to them. 3 Some men came, bringing to him a paralytic, carried by four of them. 4 Since they could not get him to Jesus because of the crowd, they made an opening in the roof above Jesus, and after digging through it, lowered the mat the paralyzed man was lying on. 5 When Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralytic, "Son, your sins are forgiven." NIV

* Go where you need to go and do what you need to do to find freedom.

B) GET YOUR STUFF OUT NOW

Don't be silenced by shame - to get out of your shame, you must blame

Don't be fettered by fear - lay aside your reputation

* Ask God to reveal what's in your life that is holding back your freedom.

21 DAYS OF DELIVERANCE TO WALK IN WHOLENESS AND RESTORATION

The following manual is designed to provide a 21-day plan for those who have just received deliverance. The commitment to work on new habits and disciplines, we believe, will help you maintain your deliverance. Taking a personal inventory of your life and your deliverance will help to define the areas of focus. You are a direct beneficiary of God's miraculous healing.

God will make you a new creation in all aspect of who you are as a person. He promises. We seek His perfect will and purpose for our lives. Nothing will replace that. The manual is only to help define those areas of our lives that need healing and fresh change to better serve the Lord and to maintain the victory He has given. There is nothing we need to do to make Him love us more. He already sent His only begotten Son so that we would have life and have it more abundantly. We already are awarded the prize. What we can do is to honor Him by the way we live our lives so that we can be a witness to His power and might. Our prayer is that you would have your will submitted to Him so that you can receive His purpose for your life.

Often in deliverance, individuals decide that after their miraculous healing, they return to a lifestyle, circumstances or choices that thwart their deliverance by living the way they always lived before. Comfortable is the always better. However, there are changes and choices that need to be made to be able to live more fully in His highest calling and purpose.

In the manual, the questions provided encourage you to restore God's utmost position by covering seven areas of your spiritual and physical lives. You will lead daily in answering questions, journaling, praying and making Godly confessions. When self esteem is mentioned, the reference is to the person God made you to be and His destiny for you versus selfish focus.

Be encouraged in the work ahead of you. Embrace what the Lord has done for you. Don't turn back, no matter what the enemy throws at you. Stand on the fact that Greater is He who is in you than he who is in the world.

21 DAYS OF DELIVERANCE WORKSHEET 1 DAY_____

Pray the curse breaking prayer. Establish strong new spiritual habits and take time necessary to complete work each day. You are worth it.

Pray Father God: Lead me in healing and answering the questions in truth and divine revelation.

Daily Questions- Your Deliverance, Dealing with Forgiveness, Restored Self Esteem, Lost Goals and Opportunities, Getting Your Life Back, Self Improvement, Establishing Healthy Relationships, Forgiveness.
